Dr. Joerg Mayer was presented with this rabbit which had a case of chronic upper respiratory infection (Bordetella, Pasteurella mix). Baytril was used for a while and the rabbit got better. When Baytril was stopped, the rabbit got worse. Then the rabbit was put on fofenicol (Nuflor). Maxi/Guard Zn7 Derm was used as an aid for healing and not as a primary remedy. The client applied Zn7 Derm twice a day for two days and called in to report that the area was nearly gone.
